Earlier on **Saturday January 26**, many local groups will gather in Justin Herman Plaza for the annual rally for reproductive rights, in recognition of the 40th anniversary of Roe v. Wade. Featuring speakers, music, a flash mob, and fun for the kids, this **'Celebration of Women, Life & Liberty'** will take place from 10 am-noon. In past years, local atheists have participated in a show of solidarity and support in the fight to protect access to health care and family planning.

Across town at the same time, in the Civic Center Plaza, the annual religious 'Walk for Life' anti-abortion event will take place, with a march down Market Street planned for 1:30. This rally includes tens of thousands of church goers bused in from around the state. (no formal protest is planned this year)
